

VAD-C Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

What are the requirements to take the exam?

- Employed in a position that includes care for LVAD patients for a minimum of 1-year
- Place of employment is accredited in Quality and Safety and has a program that is certified (or affiliated with) in Ventricular Assist Devices by an approved Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) agency (or international v4.0 Copyright 2022 Updated November 2022; August 2022 4 equivalent), -OR- an entity that supports those organizations (with the exception of those that are solely pediatric and not able to be certified)
- Work in an applicable profession and hold licensure in the respective field or equivalent educational degree:
 - Registered Nurse (such as RN, LPN)
 - Advanced Practice Providers (such as Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant)
 - Physicians (such as MD, DO)
 - Perfusionist (such as CCP)
 - Biomedical Engineer (Bachelor's degree or above)
 - Equipment Specialist (Associates degree or above) o International Equivalent

How do I apply to take the exam?

- Click on the "VAD-C" Certification tab
- There will be a link to click on to submit candidacy application

How much does the exam cost?

- \$375
- For those that require a **retake exam**, there is a \$75 fee

When will I receive my score?

 PSI (our partner in creating the exam) has determined we will need a minimum number of test takers before we can do analyses to determine the final passing scores

What if I miss my exam appointment?

"If you fail to report for an examination, you will forfeit the registration fee and all fees
paid to take the examination. A new application form and examination fee are required to
apply for examination", found in VAD-C Candidate Handbook under <u>Failing to Report For

Do I have to renew my certification?

- Certification is valid for 3 years from the date of issue on your certification paperwork
- Renewal will be either by re-examination or meeting renewal criteria listed on the VAD-C website
